7.A. MOTION – Approve the Results of the 2021 Primary Election.

Director of Administrative Services/City Recorder Fionnuala Kofoed presented the item. During the Eagle Mountain City Primary Election of August 10, 2021, 3,041 ballots were cast representing 15.03% of the City's 20,228 registered voters. Voter turnout per district resulted in 18.96% of EM01, 16.49% of EM02, 16.29% of EM03, 11.78% of EM04, 13.01% of EM05, 11.85% of EM06, 17.38% of EM07, 14.99% of EM08, and 16.30% of EM09. One provisional ballot was cast on election day and counted and 65 ballots were rejected due to seven missing signatures, seven signatures that did not match, and 51 ballots with improper postmarks after the August 9, 2021 deadline. The total votes cast for each primary candidate are as follows: Brett Wright 1537, Rich Wood 1314, Donna Rivera Burnham 1097, Jason Allen 763, Tyler Shimakonis 477, and Maria Hopkin 463. Based upon the results, the four candidates nominated to be on the General Election ballot are Brett Wright, Rich Wood, Donna Rivera Burnham, and Jason Allen.

MOTION: *Board Member Clark moved that the Board of Canvassers verify the results of the election by ratifying the results of the canvass; accept the report of the Election Official and certify the election results; and declare City Council candidates Brett Wright, Rich Wood, Donna Rivera Burnham, and Jason Allen eligible to be on the ballot and nominated for the General Municipal Election on November 2, 2021. Board Member Love seconded the motion. Those voting aye: Donna Burnham, Melissa Clark, Colby Curtis, and Carolyn Love. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.*
