## **16. EAGLE MOUNTAIN RETAIL**

- 16.A [ORDINANCE/PUBLIC HEARING - An Ordinance of Eagle Mountain City, Utah, Amending the General Plan Future Land Use Map and Rezoning Certain Lands Known As Eagle Mountain Retail.](#)

BACKGROUND: *(Presented by Senior Planner David Stroud)* The proposed ordinance amends the General Plan Land Use Map from Neighborhood Residential One and Community Commercial to Regional Commercial and Parks and Open Space, and rezones the subject parcel from Agriculture and Commercial to Commercial Regional and Open Space-I for the purpose of permitting "big box" development. The subject property is located at the northwest intersection of SR-73 and Spring Run Parkway. This is the proposed location for a Walmart Supercenter.

BACKGROUND: *(Presented by Planning Manager Robert Hobbs)* The proposed ordinance amends the Eagle Mountain City General Plan Future Land Use Map and rezones approximately 102 acres of property on Utah County Parcel Numbers 59:006:0042, 59:006:0046, 59:006:0047, 59:006:0054, and 59:006:0055. The applications also include a request to waive the Master Development requirements found in EMMC 16.10 Master Developments. This item was remanded back to the Planning Commission at the May 16, 2023 City Council meeting to consider all of the applicants' land and provide a recommendation regarding the minimum average lot size.

BACKGROUND: *(Presented by Planning Manager Robert Hobbs)* The applicants are requesting the City Council waive the requirements found in Eagle Mountain Municipal Code Chapter 16.10 Master Developments.

- 18.A [ORDINANCE/PUBLIC HEARING - An Ordinance of Eagle Mountain City, Utah, Amending Eagle Mountain Municipal Code Chapter 17.75 Standards for Special Uses, and Sections 17.20.050 Conditional Uses \(Agriculture Zone\), 17.35.030 Land Use Table \(Commercial Zones\), and 17.40.040 Conditional Uses \(Industrial Zone\) Regarding Automobile Sales, Kennels, Racetracks, and Communication Facility Generators.](#)

BACKGROUND: *(Presented by Planner Steven Lehmitz)* The proposed ordinance adds kennels as a Conditional Use in the Agriculture and Industrial Zones, adds racetracks as a Conditional Use in the Industrial Zone, outlines Special Use standards for automobile sales and racetrack uses, and permits generators in conjunction with communication facilities and towers. The amendment also removes superscript "5" from the Commercial Zone Land Use Table; the footnote stating, "These special uses are considered prohibited until special use standards specific to these uses are approved and included in Chapter 17.75 EMMC." This item was tabled at the June 20, 2023 City Council meeting, and the public hearing was continued to this meeting.

- 18.B [ORDINANCE/PUBLIC HEARING - An Ordinance of Eagle Mountain City, Utah, Amending the Eagle Mountain Municipal Code Chapter 17.10 Definitions, Chapter 17.38 Commercial Storage Zone, and Chapter 17.40 Industrial Zone, Regarding Caretaker Dwellings.](#)

BACKGROUND: *(Presented by Senior Planner David Stroud)* The proposed ordinance amends EMMC Chapter 17.10 Definitions to add "Caretaker Dwelling," and amends Chapter 17.38 Commercial Storage Zone and Chapter 17.40 Industrial Zone to permit a caretaker dwelling as a conditional use in each zone. This item was tabled at the June 20, 2023 City Council meeting, and the public hearing was continued to this meeting.

BACKGROUND: *(Presented by Planning Manager Robert Hobbs)* The proposed ordinance includes amendments to Title 17 that provide definitions and parameters for alleys, service drives and ADA parking clarifications. This item was tabled at the June 20, 2023, City Council meeting, and the public hearing was continued to this meeting.

BACKGROUND: *(Presented by Planning Manager Robert Hobbs)* The proposed ordinance enacts EMMC Chapter 16.56 Vacation of Rights-of-Way to allow for the vacation of public streets and alleys without having to execute a plat amendment. This item was tabled at the June 20, 2023 City Council meeting, and the public hearing was continued to this meeting.

- 18.E [ORDINANCE/PUBLIC HEARING - An Ordinance of Eagle Mountain City, Utah, Amending the Eagle Mountain Municipal Code, Section 17.60.120 General Fencing Provisions, Regarding Golf Course Netting.](#)

BACKGROUND: *(Presented by Senior Planner David Stroud)* The proposed ordinance amends EMMC Section 17.60.120 General Fencing Provisions, to create netting standards on property adjacent to a golf course.

BACKGROUND: *(Presented by Economic Development Director Evan Berrett)* This project allows for the creation of a Community Reinvestment Area in order to allow for a data center project development on approximately 490 acres on the western border of the Meta datacenter property. When all phases have been triggered for the first six buildings, the City will receive approximately \$140,000 annually in property tax until the incentive expires. The interlocal agreement allows Utah County to transmit certain incremental tax revenue for Eagle Mountain City to the Redevelopment Agency of Eagle Mountain City for execution of the project area plan and budget.

BACKGROUND: *(Presented by Economic Development Director Evan Berrett)* The development agreement relates to the development of the QTS Eagle Mountain I, LLC property within the Sweetwater Industrial Park Community Reinvestment Area #3.
